We will visit the site of the first Women's Rights Convention in 1848 and learn about the global struggle for civil rights and equality. We will have a guided Ranger Talk in the Historic Wesleyan Church and be able to visit the grounds of the Elizabeth Cady Stanton Home, the M'Clintock home and the Visitor Center which features two floors of museum exhibits.

Rich Ontario sandy loam soil, brought here by glaciers at the end of the Ice Age, makes their vineyards one of the best places to grow grapes in the Finger Lakes. ****Includes five wine tastings.*****
